The LCMS Kansas District LCMS will be hosting a LERT (Lutheran Early Response Team) training on Saturday, October 19, from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Registration is \$35 per person, which covers the cost of the training, snacks and lunch. Please register by October 5. At the close of the program, participants will receive a certificate of participation and LERT volunteer credentialing issued by LCMS Disaster Response. This six-hour training event will equip attendees to be effective volunteers should a disaster strike our community, state or nation. This training is hosted by the LCMS Kansas District.
