As of January 2010, by federal guidelines, any volunteer responding to a disaster must be trained and certified or they will be turned away. The LCMS Kansas District will be hosting a LERT (Lutheran Early Response Training) event on Saturday, Sept. 28, from 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m. Registration is \$25 per person, which covers the cost of the training, snacks and lunch. Please register by Sept. 14. At the close of the program, participants will receive a certificate of participation and LERT volunteer credentialing issued by LCMS Disaster Response. This 6-hour training event will equip attendees to be effective volunteers should a disaster strike our community, state or nation. This training is hosted by the LCMS Kansas District.

Together we will walk through a simple training program designed to help us serve as trained Christian volunteers when a disaster strikes. At the center of the LERT volunteer training is one thing— MERCY! Christ’s mercy is the basis for everything we say and do.
