KEYNOTE SPEAKER: Lisa Hellyer

Lisa Hellyer serves as a Senior Ministry Advancement Counselor for Lutheran Hour Ministries, a position she has held since February 2023. In this position, she provides opportunities for Christians to support LHM through current and pledged gifts and helps to develop new and unique ways for donors to make an impact through LHM.

Prior to joining LHM, Lisa spent four years as director of engagement and outreach for LeadaChild Society. During her time there, she was primarily responsible for connecting with new and existing donors as well as sharing the ministry with local congregations. She previously spent three decades as a Director of Christian Education in developing local and global mission efforts. She was heavily involved in building a global partnership with a church and school in Haiti and led efforts to engage the congregation in serving the community.

She earned a bachelor's degree in education from Concordia University, Chicago, a master's degree in family life ministry from Concordia University, Nebraska, and a Director of Christian Education certification from Concordia University, Chicago. Lisa lives in Raymore, Missouri, and volunteers as the dean of Classic KINDLE, a Lutheran organization devoted to fostering and multiplying Christ-like servant leaders. She attends Christ Lutheran Church in Overland Park, Kansas.

Pastor Quentin Nuttmann is Senior Pastor of Our Redeemer Lutheran Church in Hutchinson, Kansas. He has a rich background that has uniquely equipped him to bring the scriptures to life.
